





Parenting Sharing - A Good Use of Encouragement <<See the Sparkle in Children—Alfred Adler's Encouragement Principle>> by Ying-shi Chang



Psychologist Rudolf Dreikurs once said "A child needs encouragement like a plant needs water". The book author Chang introduces the principle of encouragement based on Deikurs' view and clarifies the difference between encouragement and praising. Chang also shares "five rules of encouragement":

1. Affirming special quality and skills

E,g, You are a loving and generous child. You are willing to share your toys with others so that other people can have fun together too.

2. Emphasizing contribution and thankfulness

E.g. Thank you for keeping your little sister's company while Mummy is cooking dinner. That way, your little sister won't come to the kitchen for Mummy and I can finish the cooking as soon as possible.

3. Emphasizing hard work and improvement

E.g. You have spent lots of time practicing going backward with the roller blades. Your skill is getting better and better.

4. Displaying Confident

E,g. You have practiced this story for many times. I am sure you are able to tell an amazing story when you are on stage tomorrow. I have confidence in you. You can do it!

5. Expressing acceptance and recognition

E.g. Yo<mark>u are ve</mark>ry excited to share your drawing with me. You must be very satisfied with your work.
